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THE 18TH WFC BIENNIAL CONGRESS

The WFC World Congress is a **biennial congress** which member countries take turns in hosting. The congress is one of the **largest chiropractor congresses in the world** with participants from all continents. All chiropractors are welcome, regardless of where they come from or where they studied. Unique to the congress is the **link between research and clinical practice**, which is why there is a strong focus on strengthening the relationship and collaboration across disciplines.

Who participates? Up to 800 participants from all over the world are expected, the majority of them from Denmark, the USA, Canada and most of the European countries. Most participants will be clinicians practicing in a chiropractor clinic, but there will also be researchers from universities and research institutions from all over the world as well as chiropractors employed in hospitals, health clinics, sports clubs or administrative positions.

In addition, politicians from the **national chiropractor associations as well as stakeholders** from other organizations as well as professional societies participate. In addition, guests from home and abroad are invited from insurance companies, universities, professional societies and politics.





The congress lasts **three full days**, during which there will be various plenary and breakout sessions. The target group is clinical practice, which will also be reflected in the academic programme, which will focus on the **latest knowledge**, **research and implementation in practice**. There will be sessions where new research will be presented by researchers from around the world for sessions of a more clinical nature which will allow the participant to get hands-on. During all breaks, catering will take place in the common area, where the exhibitors also have stands. This means that all exhibitors are centrally located. There will therefore be a good opportunity to meet the participants during the breaks when talk, fun and catering take place around all the exhibitors.

World Federation of Chiropractic (WFC)

The World Federation of Chiropractic was established in 1988 and is working with the global development of chiropractic profession.

The WFC's voting members are national associations of chiropractors. Representing the interests of the profession in over 90 countries worldwide, the WFC has advocated, defended, and promoted the profession across its 7 world regions.

The WFC has a vision of a world where people may enjoy universal access to chiropractic so that populations may thrive and reach their full potential. To help achieve this, the WFC works to advance awareness, utilization, and integration of chiropractic internationally.

The WFC is organized into an Executive Committee, a board of Directors, a Research Committee, a Public Health Committee, and a Disability and Rehabilitation Committee. The WFC organization reflects the fact that the WFC is a world organisation, as the various members of the organisation come from all over the world.



The Danish Chiropractors' Association (DCA)

Founded in 1925, the DCA is a professional association organizing more than 1000 chiropractors and chiropractic students. The DCA is the representative body mangler der noget i sætningen - måske ensuring representation chiropractors in and around the Danish healthcare system. And ensuring that chiropractic is practised under well-organized and regulated conditions in Denmark. The DCA is highly engaged in the promotion and development of chiropractic, research, and education, and the DCA cooperates closely with The Chiropractic Knowledge Hub, The University of Southern Denmark, World Federation of Chiropractic and The Danish Society of Chiropractic.



Together with the Danish Government (the Danish Regions) the DCA runs the chiropractic Foundation which supports research and other projects. Over the last 30 years the fund has contributed with over 100 million US dollars to research and other projects to develop the profession.



The Chiropractic Knowledge Hub

Founded on 15 June 1990 as the Nordic Institute of Chiropractic and Clinical Biomechanics (NIKKB), the Chiropractic Knowledge Hub advances musculoskeletal health for the benefit of citizens and the society, nationally and internationally. The core task of the Chiropractic Knowledge Hub is to support the role of the chiropractic profession in the Danish health care system as well as contributing to the evidence-based managing of musculoskeletal matters. The researchers at Chiropractic Knowledge Hub have contributed to over 600 peer-review articles and many of the researchers are global leading experts within their fields.


The Chiropractic Knowledge Hub is providing postgraduate courses for the Danish chiropractors and has two divisions which work with X-ray quality and data-based quality improvement in the chiropractic clinics.





Terms of payment

Full amount is payable within 14 days after signing the Application Form. All payments must be received on or before 16 April 2025 to participate and for acknowledgement in print materials.

Cancellation terms

Following receipt of the approved Application Form, the order is binding and the company is committed to pay as per the above specified payment terms.

Cancellations before 7 May 2024 will incur a cancellation fee of 10% of the total commitment, remainder of the paid fees will be refunded.

Cancellations before 7 November 2024 will incur a cancellation fee of 25% of the total commitment, remainder of the paid fees will be refunded.

Cancellations after 8 November 2024 are non-refundable and require full payment of the amount stated in the order confirmation. The above applies even if the company withdraws from the contract or does not participate in the event.

Cancellation by organiser

Should any force majeure event prevent or unreasonably delay at least 25% of expected WFC 2025 attendees from participating at the event, making it thereby inadvisable, illegal,



impossible, or commercially impractical to hold WFC 2025 or to fully perform the terms of the agreement, the agreement may be terminated without penalty and with performance fully excused for any or more of these reasons by written notice from the organiser to the company. We will endeavor to refund as much of the received fees as possible, however WFC 2025 reserves the right to deduct the already incurred costs of the congress before such refund. The remaining funds will be allocated proportionately among the sponsors and exhibitors.


Congress center and hotel under one roof
